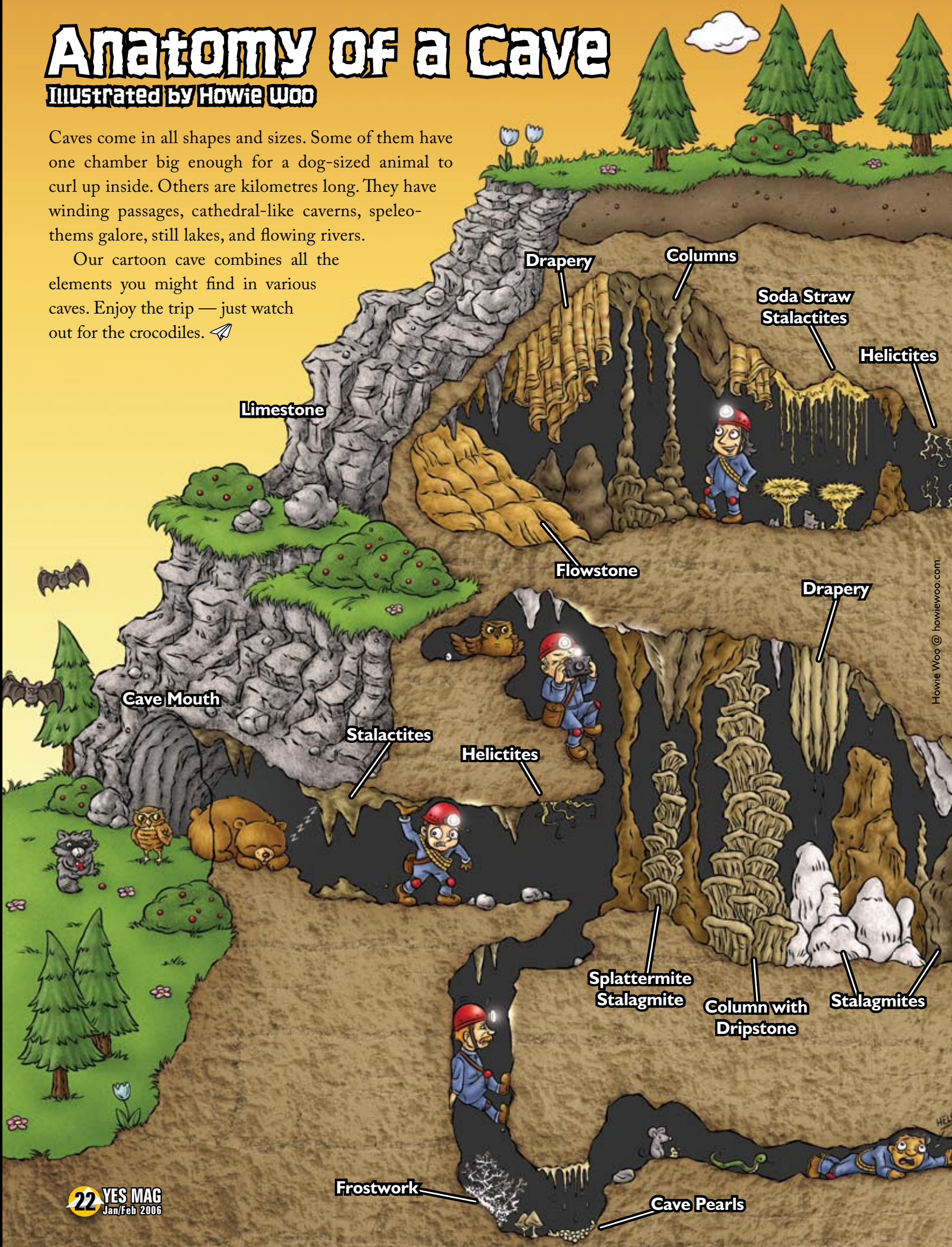


Anatomy of a Cave
